VI. Shadows (vs. 16, 17)

What is a “New Moon celebration”?

“The law is only a shadow of the good things are coming – not the realities themselves. For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship.” Hebrews 10:1 (NIV)

Reality (vs. 16, 17)

“The former regulations set aside because it is weak and useless (for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God... because of this oath, Jesus has become the guarantee of a better covenant... Therefore, He is able to save completely those who come to God through Him...” Hebrews 7:18, 19, 22, 25 (NIV)
